TESTING CALENDAR

- District Local Measures testing (Achieve3000, iReady Math & iReady ASR-DLIP) for 3rd - 6th will take place May 13th – May 31st. Your student will begin these tests after their completion of CAASPP tests. Your student's teacher can provide a more specific date per class.
- State Summative CAASPP testing for grades 3rd – 6th will proceed as follows:

CAASPP ELA / Math (5 th & 6 th grade)	May 6 – May 10
CAASPP ELA / Math (3 rd & 4 th grade)	May 13 – May 17
CAST (Science Assessment for 5 th)	May 15 – May 16

We ask that you attempt to limit absences (appointments/vacations) during the testing windows to create a stable testing environment with minimal distractions and make-up testing.

By working together, we can make your child's testing experience positive and successful. Here are some suggestions that will help your child succeed:

Get a good night's rest	Arrive at school on time
Eat a healthy breakfast	Gently remind your child to always do their best
